By submitting this application form, the applicant hereby agrees to freely and voluntarily authorise the Darul Ifta to arbitrate in this Nikah according to its procedures for Islamic marital arbitration and hereby agrees to abide by the decision of the Darul Ifta accordingly. It is the policy of Darul Ifta that every application follows a due procedure involving an assessment of the case having consulted all concerned parties. To ensure this, the Darul Ifta makes all reasonable effort to communicate with all parties. Based on this assessment, the Council's independent panel of scholars will arbitrate, relying upon the merits and validity of the case.

Darul Ifta makes its decision based on the teachings of the Islamic faith and takes no responsibility for any financial or other loss which may accrue to the parties involved. In the case the Darul Ifta dissolves a Nikah, it is only according to the Islamic faith. For a civil law divorce, a solicitor should be consulted. It is the Darul Ifta policy that we advise all parties who seek the Council's advice in Islamic marital mediation and arbitration, that violent and or criminal incidents are referred to the relevant legal authorities such as the police and social services.
